## Pay Level Survey Advisory Committee

Thank you for your letter of 3 January 1987 in reply to our letter of 29 December 1986 in which we detailed the reasons for our withdrawal from the Pay Level Survey Advisory Committee meetings.

We felt great disappointment at the Standing Commission's refusal to provide the vital data necessary for the evaluation of the survey results, thus rendering it impossible for the Staff Side Representatives on the Pay Level Survey Advisory Committee to fulfil their role as members of the Committee and their duty to their own members. All along, the Staff Side has endeavoured to give full support to the survey, pointing out doubtful areas in principles and methodology, factors for job evaluations and assumptions for computing survey results. We have addressed the issue very seriously and have devoted much time in examining the Survey Report. As a result, we have pin-pointed inaccuracies in the reported results for civil service housing benefits, medical and dental benefits, retirement benefits and personal loans. It was with great reluctance that we found it necessary to withdraw from PLSAC meetings.
