

CHAPTER TEN

FUTURE PROGRAMME OF WORK

10.1 There remain 216 grades which we have to examine in the overall salary structure review. In drawing up our next programme of work, we have taken note of the concern of staff about the timing of their grade review and the desire to have the review completed as early as possible. To have further phasing in dealing with the remaining 216 grades will inevitably give rise to questions of priority. We have therefore decided to examine all these grades in one phase. This will take about nine months to complete and we plan to submit our final report on the review to the Governor at the end of 1990, thereby finishing the entire review ahead of the original target of two years.

10.2 Although the focus in the next phase will be on examining the salary and structure of individual grades, where necessary we shall study and advise on any general issues that may arise.
