CHAPTER 1

INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 Since our establishment in 1979, we have been publishing regular progress reports on the work and activities of the Standing Commission. This is our tenth progress report and it gives a general account of our work during 1990.
- 1.2 1990 was a very busy year for the Commission. We continued to focus on the overall review of the salary structure of the non-directorate grades, which began in 1989. The review has now been completed and a summary of our work is given in Chapter 2.
- 1.3 In November 1990, having taken account of the advice of the Pay Trend Survey Committee and the views expressed in other quarters, we proposed a change of the survey period for the annual pay trend surveys to address the problem of time-lag. Details of our proposals are given in Chapter 3.
- During the year, we also reviewed the civil service housing benefits and advised on the proposal for a special allowance for the General Duties Team staff in the Urban Services and Regional Services Departments. A summary of our recommendations is given in Chapter 4.
- 1.5 In Chapter 5, we record the work of the Pay Survey and Research Unit in 1990.
- 1.6 In May 1990, Mrs. Alice Lam and Miss Therese Chan retired from the Commission. Mrs. Lam has been a member for eight years and Miss Chan for six years. We are most grateful to them for their valuable contributions to the work of the Commission.
- 1.7 We would like to record our thanks to the Secretary for the Civil Service and his staff for their general assistance and co-operation during the year. We would also like to express to the Secretary-General and his staff our deep appreciation for their hard work and unfailing support during another very hectic period of the Commission's activities.
