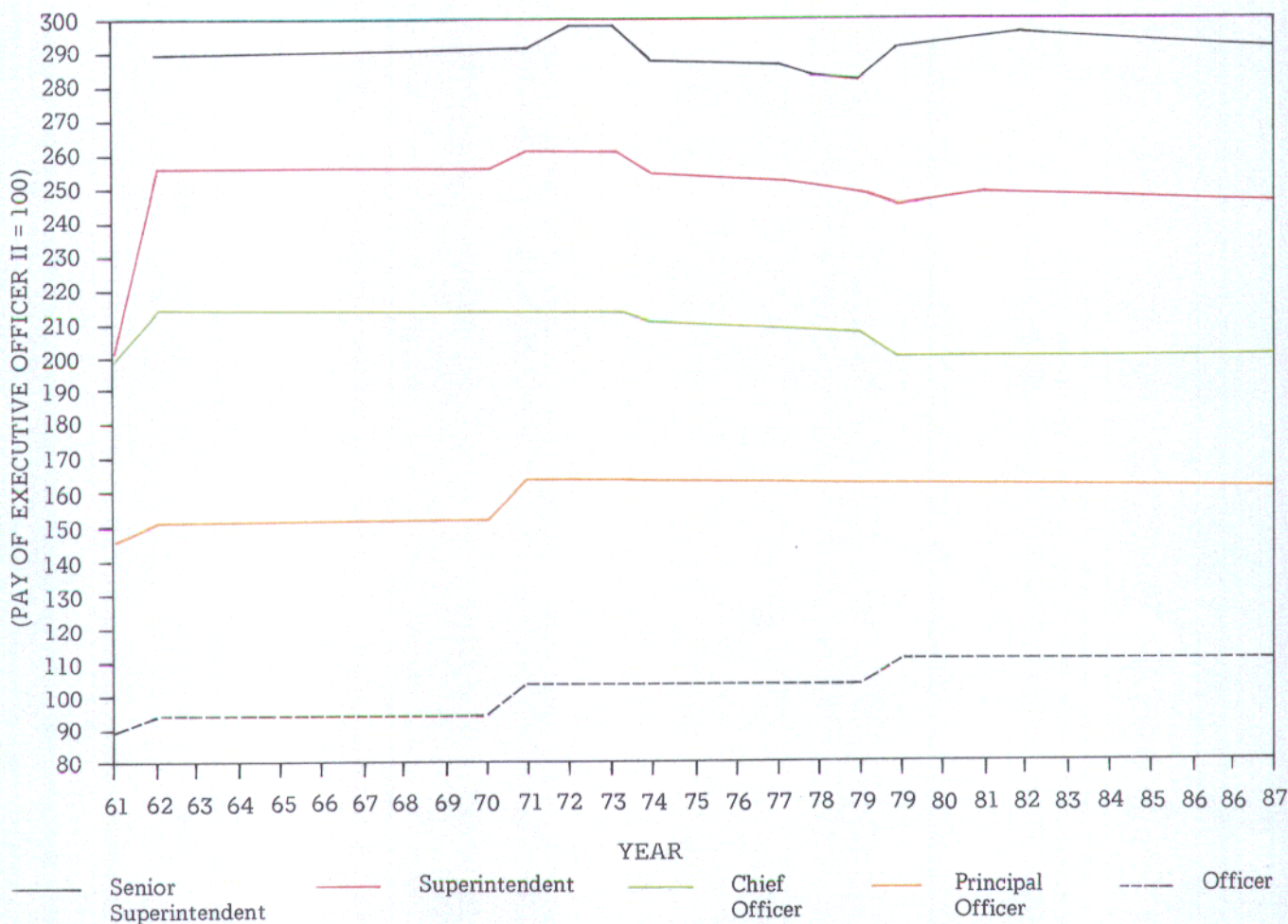


## CORRECTIONAL SERVICES — OFFICER



## Note

- (1) This chart compares the pay levels of the ranks of Officer, Principal Officer, Chief Officer, Superintendent and Senior Superintendent (of Correctional Services Department) with that of Executive Officer II.
- (2) The comparison is based on the arithmetic mean of the dollar value of the minimum and maximum points of the rank scales.
- (3) The rank of Officer was known as Prison Officer prior to 1972. The arithmetic mean of this rank in 1961 is calculated by using the minimum of the then Prison Officer II rank and the maximum of the then Prison Officer I rank.
- (4) The rank of Chief Officer was restructured in 1962 by combining the former ranks of Chief Officer and Assistant Chief Officer. The arithmetic mean of this rank prior to the restructuring is calculated by using the minimum of the then Assistant Chief Officer rank and the maximum of the then Chief Officer rank.
- (5) The rank of Superintendent was restructured in 1962. Prior to that the salary scale for Superintendent (\$1,900 – \$3,820) was designed for direct entry to that rank at an early age, hence the relatively low starting pay.
- (6) The new rank of Senior Superintendent was created in 1962.
